College Credit Plus (CCP) replaced Ohio's Post-Secondary Enrollment Options and Dual Enrollment programs for students to receive college credit while in high school. Students participate in these programs when they have *maximized* participation in a subject area of Bishop Hartley's curriculum (i.e. completing a World Language by junior year and wishing to continue education in the language before graduation).

A representative from Columbus State Community College, our CCP partner, will be presenting information regarding College Credit Plus here at Bishop Hartley on Thursday, January 30th at 6:30pm in our Lecture Hall. Please attend if your student may qualify for post-secondary credit before graduation from Hartley. Counselors have communicated with your student whether he/she may be eligible for a CCP course offered here at Hartley.

The following courses are eligible for credit through Columbus State's College Credit Plus Program taught here on our campus at Bishop Hartley: *Calculus II (Math 1152)* and *Statistics (Statistics 1450)*.
