## MENINGITIS VACCINE REQUIRED FOR CLASS OF 2021

---

This a reminder that all students entering the twelfth grade are required by state law to be fully immunized against Meningitis. To be fully immunized students must have 2 doses of the vaccine, but if a dose is received on or after the sixteenth birthday, only one dose is required. If you have questions or if you are unsure if your student has been fully immunized, contact me or your health care provider.

Documentation verifying that the immunization has been given is required for school attendance and must be submitted to the school nurse prior to entering the twelfth grade.
