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WORLD LANGUAGE TESTING

Students who are not currently enrolled in a Spanish or French language class who feel they may be able to demonstrate proficiency in Spanish or French in order to enroll in Level II or III may take the Spanish/French Placement Test on Monday, March 16, 2020. This is a Reading and Writing Test along with a Conversational Interview to measure Speaking and Listening proficiency. TESTING DAY INFORMATION

Spring testing day is Tuesday, March 10th. Please see the information below regarding our schedule for that day:

Freshmen: IOWA Tests

Time: 7:45 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Sophomores: PreACT

Time: 7:45 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Juniors: ACT

Time: 7:45 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

- Notre Dame students will receive accommodations according to their plans;

Seniors

- do not report to school;

DRESS – PLEASE NOTE: Students may dress in red and blue in accordance with school policy.

MATERIALS: All students should bring with them pencils and an approved calculator to their tests.

Iowa Tests: The State of Ohio has offered the Diocesan schools an optional pathway to meeting the graduation requirement of demonstrating proficiency in English I and II, Algebra, Geometry, American History, and American Government. The format of these tests is paper and pencil and familiar to our students from our Catholic grade schools and probably to graduates from other schools as well.

PreACT: This is the second practice assessment for sophomores who will take the ACT their junior year.

ACT: The State of Ohio funds this test when administered by the school on this date. Hartley's School Counseling Office will register the juniors for this administration of the ACT.

Please note that this version of the ACT does not include the Writing section.

There is no direct cost to you.

Please note, however, that should your student retake the ACT at an official testing site on another date, the responsibility for registration and fees is yours.

CREED: Seniors are responsible for completing a culmination project in which they reflect on their high school community service, demonstrate their understanding of Catholic social teaching, identify the roles of the three branches of government that play in meeting the needs of the community, and demonstrate mastery of the production of written composition.

NURSE'S NOTES

An important message for all junior parents from the School Nurse

This a reminder that all students entering the twelfth grade are required by state law to be fully immunized against meningitis. To be fully immunized students must have 2 doses of the meningococcal vaccine, but if a dose is received on or after the sixteenth birthday, only one dose is required. If you have questions or if you are unsure if your student has been fully immunized, contact me or your health care provider.

Documentation verifying that the immunization has been given is required for school attendance and must be submitted to the school nurse prior to entering the twelfth grade.
