As part of our reopening plan for the 2020-2021 school year, we have formally and informally evaluated our plan through the first quarter. As of today, 1.6% of our faculty, staff, and students have been infected by the Coronavirus since the beginning of the school year. While any number of infections are concerning, we are confident that our plan is working to mitigate the spread of the virus to the best of our abilities.

Governor DeWine's office reports that cases are on the rise in Central Ohio and Franklin County. Additionally, the mandate of six feet of social distancing remains from not only the Governor's office but the Office of Catholic Schools. As a result, we will continue to operate in our Hybrid Model for Quarter 2. A copy of the Red and Blue day by day breakdown is attached. All students who were enrolled in our Hawks Learning at Home (Full Remote Learning) for Quarter 1 should have received a survey to discuss their choice for Quarter 2. If you have not filled out this survey, you need to contact the School Counseling Office as soon as possible.

The Hybrid Model decision will be revisited as new information is made available throughout the pandemic. Our hope and prayer are that we can return to 100% capacity when it is safe to do so. Should the need arise, we also are prepared to go into Full Remote Learning.
