In addition to our weekly COVID-19 Dashboard, we want to provide you an update on winter sports and to remind you of the Ohio Department of Health Advisory when it comes to travel.

Winter Sports Update

On Thursday, November 19th, the Board of Control for the Central Catholic League (CCL) voted unanimously to suspend all winter sports scrimmages and games until Dec. 18th. This is in adherence to the advisory issued for Columbus and Franklin County. As a league, we feel it's important to keep our winter athletes active and together during this pause in scrimmages and games. We are allowing winter teams to practice up to Nov. 25th as we begin Thanksgiving break. Winter teams will return to practice on Nov. 30th.

All spring sports will stop training at 6pm on Nov. 20th through Dec. 18th. We will continue to monitor the situation and update you as to when Spring training can resume.

As Governor DeWine, the CDC, OHD and Diocese continue to analyze the data and make decisions, we will update you on the CCL's plan to keep our athletes safe and active.

Ohio Department of Health Advisory

Those entering Ohio after travel to states reporting positive testing rates of 15% or higher for COVID-19 are advised to self-quarantine for 14 days.

Positivity rate is an indicator of how much COVID-19 there is in a community, and ODH is recommending against travel to those states with high positivity. If someone must travel, ODH is recommending 14 days of self-quarantine after leaving those locations. This advisory is intended for both leisure and business travel and should be heeded by both Ohioans and out-of-state travelers. It is intended as guidance and is not a mandate—please consider the information here along with other factors (mode of transportation, lodging, activities, ability to social distance when traveling, personal health factors, etc.) when making travel decisions for yourself and your family.
