The Charles L. Warren Memorial Heritage Scholarship

The Charles L. Warren Memorial Heritage Scholarship is now available for eligible students to submit.

The OACAC Inclusion, Access and Success Committee would like you to forward the application to deserving students at your high school. The **one-time \$1,500 scholarship** will be awarded to outstanding high school seniors.

A few things to remember - the student must:

- Demonstrate and show a continued commitment to cultural and intellectual diversity.
- Attend an OACAC member high school. Just one HS counselor needs to be a member to qualify.
- Have an accumulated grade point average of 3.00 or better on a 4.00 scale in a college preparatory curriculum
- Required to attend an **Ohio** college or university
- Submit the application, an official high school transcript, a counselor recommendation and answer a few prompts
